The spirit of Stupor!

Rom.11:8 According as it is written, "God gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear, to this very day." {Deuteronomy 29:4; Isaiah 29:10}

Do you think God deceived Israel? Now think about that shocking statement for a moment? What would that mean? After God spent life and precious blood trying to save Israel for thousand's of years; He now deceives it? 3:18 Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Romans 5:12 Therefore, as sin entered into the world through one man, and death through sin; and so death passed to all men, because all sinned.
